

Keep Fields Manure-Free This Winter

Putnam SWCD <u>never</u> recommends applying manure to frozen or snow-covered ground. However, an emergency application may be necessary to prevent storage overflow. If that occurs, remember to only spread enough manure to prevent manure overflow until soil conditions improve. Follow these guidelines, but understand that even by following them, you are still ultimately responsible if manure from your application enters waters of the state (Ditches, creeks, streams, rivers, etc.). Keep ALL manure application records for 5 years! Remember to have your soil tested every 3 years and to test your manure for nutrient levels before application. For questions on soil and manure testing, contact our office.

Referencing Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 939.08:

No person in the state of Ohio shall surface apply manure under any of the following circumstances:

- On snow-covered or frozen soil;
- When the top two inches of soil are saturated from precipitation;
- When the local weather forecast for the application area contains greater than a fifty per cent chance of precipitation exceeding one-half inch in a twenty-four-hour period.

There are a few exceptions if a person in the western basin applies manure under any of the following circumstances:

- (1) The manure is injected into the ground.
- (2) The manure is incorporated within 24-hours of surface application.
- (3) The manure is applied onto a growing crop.
